### DID YOU KNOW?

- Our JCF in the past year became the largest community foundation in NJ, and among the top ten Jewish community foundations in North America, with approximately \$800M in assets under administration and \$100M in future commitments.
- We currently hold more than 780 funds for individual, family, and foundation donors.
- Our Center for Strategic Philanthropy engages families in thoughtful and impactful philanthropy while providing a unique focus on Jewish values and community.
- JCF continues to grow its Donor Advised Fund (DAF) program—tell your friends about it!
- We currently hold \$60 million in current Perpetual Annual Campaign Endowment (PACE) funds.
- For FY22 the expected distribution to the UJA Annual Campaign is \$2.7 million. This distribution is the single largest ‘gift’ to the UJA Annual Campaign each year (12% for FY22).
- JCF awarded more than \$57M in grants last year (see reverse side for details)!
- Our JCF fundholders fund programs in Greater MetroWest and Israel, including our Jewish Day School Initiative, Jewish summer camp, Israel advocacy and education, PJ Library, Newark and Holocaust Education, Negev economic development, Next Generation leadership programs, and more.

Our JCF is poised to have even more impact in the coming years and it would not be possible without our dedicated fundholders. We look forward to continuing to share our progress with you!
